

**Log Cabin** (exit through front doors and walk down Hamilton Street) Travel back to Madison's earliest days as a community via our authentic log cabin. Try out a butter churn, play kids' games from two centuries ago, and explore the lives of early Wisconsin settlers. Closed in the winter months.

**Urb Garden**  
Sun, soil, and water abound on our three-season deck, giving ages 5 and under an up-close look at the great outdoors in the heart of the city. There's so much to do, and even a secret or two!

**Wilderness**  
It's a wonder-filled global village for our youngest visitors that mixes climbing, crawling, and exploring with texture, color, and light to create boundless opportunities!  
For visitors 5 and under.

**Community Concourse**  
Free and open to the public, our Concourse houses a water feature, art displays, and other amazing exhibits.

**Seymore's Adventures**  
Come have an adventure with Seymore the bluegill and learn about fish anatomy and lake habitats while you play!



**Art Studio**  
Get your hands on paper, clay, paint, yarn, and more. Decorate the interactive paint window. Take part in collective art projects. Be inspired by thousands of local artists—both young and old—and ever-changing gallery displays.

**Possible-opolis™**  
This kid "city" is built at the intersection of science and art. Filled with interactive games and loads of exploration and play. This exhibit space is composed of 90% recycled and repurposed materials.

**From Coops to Cathedrals**  
Explore Frank Lloyd Wright's childhood bedroom, farm, and architecture studio, but more important, use your imagination and creativity to play, design, build, and invent, just like he did!



**Rooftop Ramble**  
Get a glimpse of nature on our four-season rooftop oasis. Stop by the clubhouse to see what's growing and check out our reptiles and rodents. Scale the Acorn Climber. Get a bird's eye view of the city from the Crow's Nest.
